To help ease the burden on families during school closures, we have developed a plan to open **Emergency Day Camps for parents who qualify at four schools on Monday, March 16th from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.**

The day camps are open to parents of K-6 Boise School District students who fall into general categories such as healthcare providers, first responders, and parents required to work. Students must be dropped off in person and checked-in with an employee.
